



Alternate Fuel Options for Condensing Boilers

Propane Vapor		Propane-Air
Alternate fuel source to natural gas	\rightarrow	Interchangeable with natural gas
Boilers need to have the option for a dual fuel		Works in standard natural gas fired boilers
Dedicated propane vapor lines need to be run to boiler room and boilers may require a separate gas train for each fuel type		Single connection at the natural gas service entrance. Boilers can use the buildings same natural gas distribution pipes, valves, regulators, etc.
An option when boilers are in a centralized location		An option when gas fired equipment is in multiple locations
Only equipment selected for the single dedicated propane vapor line will continue to operate		All natural gas equipment will continue to operate <u>Examples include:</u> Food Service Equipment Condensing/Non-Condensing Boilers Gas Fired Water Heaters and Rooftop Units
Boilers needs to be stopped and restarted when switching between natural gas and propane vapor		"Switch on the fly" to and from Utility provided natural gas


